 In 1991, just one scholarship of \$250 from GC Women's Ministries was the start of the Women's Scholarship fund. With the goal of helping Adventist women attend college, the fund grew.

By **2007**, more than 1,170 scholarships, totaling **\$492,800**, had helped Adventist women in 93 countries.

And by January **2019**, GCWM awards total **\$1,271,600**, providing 2,524 scholarships to women in 136 countries.

But you can help to do more. Let's make our world better by educating our sisters and giving the world the faithful service of strong, committed Christian women.

**SPAIN:** You helped **Maite** complete her studies in Gender Violence and Psychology in 2017. Now she directs an Abuse Prevention program in her home country of Spain.



ROMANIA: Nine years ago, Lina, a Gypsy in Romania, was illiterate. Yet in just eight years she earned a Masters in Theology. Today Lina serves in a church she helped evangelize. She teaches Bible classes, provides clothing to the poor, and helps wherever needed. Her prayer now is for the opportunity to serve as a pastor among the Gypsies.
